COVID-19

1) COVID-19 PCR test

Students must take COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours prior to your flight and submit the ‘certificate of test result’ to inbound@inu.ac.kr before your departure.

2) Upon Arrival

Upon your arrival at the Incheon Airport, travelers are required to download an app used for monitoring and reporting their actions and status during the quarantine. ([Link](#))

3) Self-quarantine

Under the ‘Infectious Disease Control and Prevention Act’, inbound exchange students should be quarantined for 14 days on their arrival in Korea even if you test negative for COVID-19 or get vaccinated already. During the quarantine, going outside is prohibited. Violators may be subject to forced deportation, entry ban, etc, in accordance with the Immigration Control Act. After the self-quarantine, students can move to the assigned dormitory. ([Link](#))

INU will introduce you a quarantine company in Incheon area. The company will help you to arrange a quarantine facility, airport taxi, foods, PCR test during quarantine, etc. Details will be informed soon.

Korean Language Courses:

- ♦ We offer free Korean language courses to exchange students.
- ♦ You don't have to register the ‘Korean language courses’ during the official course registration period.
- ♦ The Korean level test will be held after the beginning of the semester.

Health Insurance

- ◆ **International Students are subject to the mandatory subscription to the Korean National Health Insurance. All international students will be automatically enrolled in the National Health Insurance.**

- ◆ You will be enrolled from the date of alien registration. (Expected date : October)
- ◆ We **highly recommend** you to buy an **international insurance** additionally just in case.
- ◆ With the Korean National Health Insurance, you pay only 30~60% of hospital bills.
- ◆ Before then, all medical costs should be covered by your own international health insurance. [Link](#)

Visa information

- ◆ Every international student studying in Korea should hold a **student visa (D-2-6)** before arrival, which can be applied for and obtained in the nearest Korean Embassy or Consulate in your country. [Link](#)
- ◆ When applying, students are required to submit the “**Certificate of Admission**”, which will be officially issued by Incheon National University.
- ◆ Please consult your local Korean Embassy regarding other required documents for your visa application.
- ◆ Check the [e-Government website](#) for Foreigners.

Alien Registration

- ◆ You will receive more information about the process at the **International Students Orientation**.
- ◆ **International office will accompany you** to Immigration office for Alien Registration.
- ◆ Within 90 days of your arrival in Korea, you **must** go to the Immigration Office to register and get a Certificate of Alien Registration, regardless of the type of visa you received.

(After arriving in Korea, you must not leave Korea before an Alien Registration Card is issued.)

◆ **Required documents:**

- Application form (obtainable at the International Office)
- One color photo (size 3cm x 4cm, white background, visible ears and forehead, should be different with the photo in your passport)
- A copy of a valid passport
- Application fee: 30,000 KRW
- Certificate of University Enrollment (prepared by the International Office)
- Proof of Residency (prepared by the International Office)

Medical Diagnosis

- ♦ Students who do not take the medical examination will not be accepted by dormitory.
- ♦ All exchange students should get a Medical Diagnosis before their arrival.
- ♦ **Please prepare medical diagnosis document in English and submit inbound@inu.ac.kr before departure.**
- ♦ Required test : Tuberculosis
