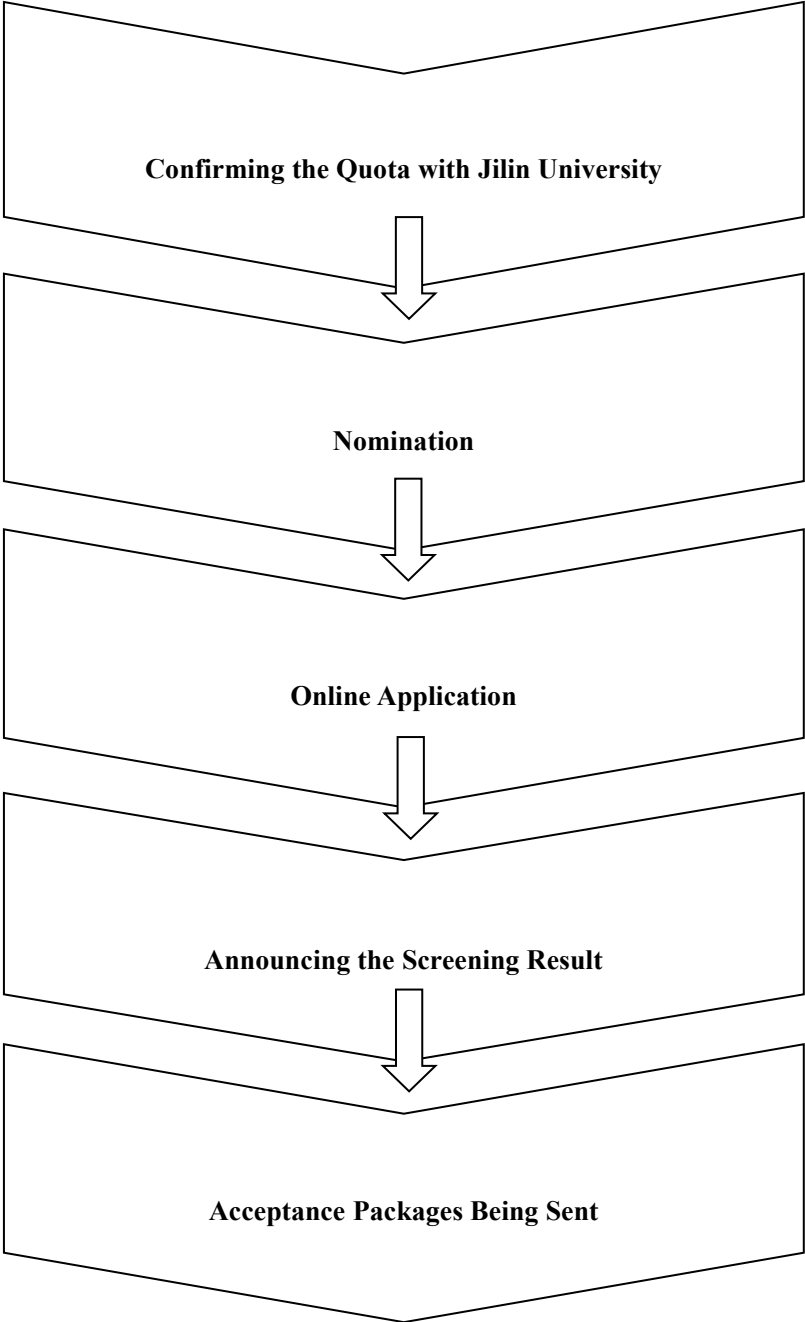

Language Requirements for Exchange Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Programs in Chinese: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Chinese Language (Non-degree Program): No language requirement. For the students who apply for the program of Chinese Language (for non-native speakers). 2) Diplomacy (School of International and Public Affairs) needs a valid HSK Level 5 score which is higher than 180 and a valid TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score which is higher than 550(PBT) or 213(CBT) or 79(IBT) or a valid IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score which is higher than 6.0. 3) Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Language (Master Degree program) needs a valid HSK Level 5 score which is higher than 180. 4) Other majors: A valid HSK Level 4 score which is higher than 180. ◆ Programs in English: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) English Language (Non-degree Program): No language requirement. 2) Other majors: There is a language test from school (Jilin University). <p>Note: no language requirement for the students who apply for the program of Chinese Language (for none-native speakers). "</p>

G. Other Information:

Age Requirement	All international students MUST be aged over 18 and under 60.
Residence Permit	All international students need a residence permit if staying longer than 6 months in China. It can be obtained under help of JLU staff after arrival.
Health Examination	Exchange students MUST go to an authorized hospital to get one after arrival in China.
Insurance	<p>All international students (including exchange students) are required to have a group comprehensive insurance, which includes an Accidental Injury Medical Treatment Insurance & a Hospitalization Medical Insurance when they arrive.</p> <p>Whether exchange students have purchased insurance in home country or not, it's necessary to purchase insurance before entering China.</p> <p>Insurance Fee: ¥400 CNY for 6 months ¥800 CNY for 12 months</p>
Housing	We provide accommodation and beds for exchange students. Exchange students live in campus in principle. We don't allow exchange students to live off campus. All rooms are double-occupancy in principle. There is a 30% off for accommodation fee.
living Expenses	<p>The living expenses (on-campus housing and meals) will be approximately ¥3000CNY per month. Following is a rough estimate of expenses for a single person living in Changchun:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Lunch or dinner at a restaurant ¥50+ CNY ◆ Public Bus ticket (one way) ¥1+ CNY ◆ Subway ¥2+ CNY ◆ Taxi ¥8+ CNY

<p>Average Temperature in Changchun</p>	<p>Changchun has four distinct seasons. Average summer temperature ranges from 20-25 °C, highest being some 30 °C, the weather is dry and usually air conditioning is not needed in summer. Average winter temperature is about -12 to -16 °C, lowest rarely reaches -30 °C. but all rooms are well heated. You could enjoy skating and skiing in winter time.</p>
