Taking a JR Train

When you exit a baggage claim, you will see **JR** (Japan Railway company) guide sign. Follow the multi-lingual signs.



Currency Exchange service is on the same floor.



Walk straight about 250 meters, then you will reach to the Domestic Terminal. Take the escalator to B1 to buy your ticket and board the train.

You can check the time schedule for the **Rapid Airport Train** bound for Sapporo.

Tickets for Sapporo Station cost 1,150 yen. You can buy them at these machines.



The machines take 1,000, 5,000, and 10,000 yen bills and give you change automatically.

Just put in your money and press this button.

Take your change and the ticket.





Put your ticket in the wicket. When it comes out on the other side, take it and keep it. You will need it when you exit at Sapporo Station. Go down the escalator to ride on a train.

You can sit in one of the **unreserved seating cars(自由席)**. Since **U-Seat** is reserved seating, you may be charged if you sit there.

- The rapid Airport train takes about 40 minutes to Sapporo Station.
- Relax and enjoy the ride.
- When you get off at Sapporo sta., there are two exits; East and West.
- Put your ticket in the wicket when exiting at Sapporo station.
- After you exit, you can find taxis at the North Exit.



JR Sapporo Station is NOT SHIN-Sapporo Station which will come up about 30 minutes from the airport. Stay on the train until just about everyone get off; it will be Sapporo Station.



Taking a bus



You will find a guide sign for the Route bus. Follow the multi-lingual signs. There is a bus information and ticket desk. You can buy tickets for the bus there. A ticket to Sapporo area costs 1,100 yen. You can ask the staff if you need help.





After confirming the time and buying the ticket, find the bus stops outside.

The bus will take you to Sapporo area for about an hour.
